

This book has fun arrangements of jazz standards. My student was impressed and looking forward to learning the songs. I enjoy in particular how some of the songs have little piano "solos" in between verses that are similar to what you might hear from a jazz band. The originals are fun as well. I only gave it 4 stars because in general I find Faber songbooks to be a bit "plain jane" when it comes to arrangements. But as long as my students enjoy them I'll keep buying them.

Faber & Faber make 15 popular jazz standards accessible for the intermediate pianist. A dictionary of musical terms is included at the back of the book.
