

The account traces progresses in Churchill's familyâ "predominantly his relationship with his wife, Clementineâ "and his governmental career.First elected to the parliament in 1900, Churchill played a dynamic role in British politics for more than five decades until he resigned as prime minister in 1955. The author stresses the prominence of his legacy by including pictorials of Churchill partaking in major historical events such as the Yalta Conference in 1945. He provides revealing interpretation on some photographs. There are citations from Churchill, his family, friends, and colleagues which appear throughout the book.This is unique compilation of documents, a book of 272 pages and 220 photographs which are visually splendid photographs.
